

# ORF-Enterprises honors Kafka on the centenary of this death

This year marks the centenary of the death of Franz Kafka, a well-known German author whose influence remains as profound and enigmatic as his works. Born in 1883 in Prague, Kafka is renowned for his unique narrative style that explores themes of alienation, bureaucracy, and existential anxiety. His works, including "The Metamorphosis", "The Trial", and "The Castle" have left a lasting mark on 20<sup>th</sup>-century literature, shaping genres such as existentialism and absurdism. Despite his untimely death on June 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1924, Kafka's legacy continues to intrigue and inspire readers worldwide, his name now synonymous with the surreal, nightmarish scenarios he so vividly depicted.

VIENNA – The internationally renowned author Daniel Kehlmann and the exceptional writer David Schalko joined forces to create "**Kafka**", a mini-series that debuted in March of this year, commemorating the life and legacy of the iconic literary figure. Guided by Kafka expert Reinhard Stach, the series was crafted for success. The show is a coproduction by ORF, NDR & Superfilm, funded by FISA +, Austrian Television Fund & Vienna Film Fund in Association with ORF-Enterprise.

At the heart of the mini-series are Kafka's remarkable love affairs with Felice Bauer, Milena Jesenska, and Dora Diamant, his difficult relationship with his tyrannical father and his close friendship with Max Brod, who ultimately betrayed his terminally ill friend but ensured his enduring fame in the process.

The series highlight sparked considerable interest among many broadcasters across the globe. Since the premiere, the Content Sales International team of ORF-Enterprise successfully licensed "**Kafka**" to Austrian neighbors Czech Republic (CT), Slovenia (RTV Slovenjia), and Switzerland (SRF) as well as Sweden (SVT), Poland (TVP), the United Kingdom (Channel 4), and Finland (YLE).
